Financial – great running start; AR up (in relation to last year) but much lower in perspective to contracts out vs. paid contracts; credit cards at nothing; line of credit at maximum amount due to buying needed instruments; sale of instruments will be used to pay off the line of credit.

Development – \$21,000 committed to date; capital campaign public announcement planned for the summer premier, June 25 at Loras; next community outreach meeting Friday, June 10 to discuss logistics and fees for use of building.

Grant and sponsorship – DRA grant fully funded for equipment (Thermo-King and waterless hot water heater) on cook truck; grant application from MacElroy rejection; sponsorship from HyVee similar to last few years.

Transportation – charter bus contract received; will use 3 of our drivers + Navigator driver on charters; souvenir driver and staff in place; semi truck drivers in place for one tractor and $\frac{1}{2}$ of season on second; staff bus renovation for floor sleeping needs to be completed.

Alumni – efforts to engage alumni via mailing; planning continues for an alumni get together at Summer Premier, June 25 at Loras College.

Boosters – bingo concession profits continue to be reviewed; car wash sites are in place; America's River Festival concession booth on Saturday, June 11; concession booth at All That Jazz events; Dubuque fireworks concession booth on July 3.

Bingo – electronic handheld bingo devices are ready; lease for \$18 per device per week; Booster Club will lease some devices for evaluation and review results.

Shows – Des Moines show at Waukee High School; band boosters engaged and local chamber support continues; KC show ticket sales going well.

Programs – Colts at camp with cornfield starting next week at Loras College; Cadets going well; Summer Band will have about 80 kids with a show at Eagle Point Park.

Summer Premier – private, invitation only reception event and alumni event planning underway; alumni support and event planned; bagpipe band, New Horizons and Summer Band may provide some involvement.
