Summer playing opportunities are very important for the continued development and future success of band students. The Colts offer this program to provide a summer performance opportunity for tri-state area instrumental students.

The Colts Summer Band is open to all interested students who are currently in a 5-8 grade school band. This four-week program will include a weekly sectional rehearsal and a performance ensemble three days per week, with a public concert at the end!

The program will run from **June 13–July 6**. Lessons will be taught before and after the ensemble rehearsal, which runs from 11:00 a.m.–12:15 p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays* during these dates at **Roosevelt Middle School**.

* Colts Summer Band will rehearse Fri., June 16th, instead of Tues., July 4th.



We have scheduled one public performance at the end of the session on July 6 at 7:00 p.m. at the **Alliant Energy Amphitheater** in the Port of Dubuque next to the historic Dubuque Star Brewery.

We are pleased to offer two instructors to further meet the educational interests of the students enrolled.

The participation fee is \$40.
